

2GHz Relocation Project Equipment Disposal Overview and Instructions

OVERVIEW: Designated 2GHz equipment (radios and power amps only) must be shipped to Sprint Nextel for disposal. Sprint Nextel expects that radios remain intact before disposal. Broadcasters will NOT remove parts from radios prior to shipment. This sheet contains instructions regarding the disposal process.

WHAT EQUIPMENT MUST BE SHIPPED TO SPRINT NEXTEL: During negotiations, Sprint Nextel and Broadcasters will specify equipment to be sent to Sprint Nextel's warehouse (i.e., items will be listed on your Schedule B); and specifically that will be all of the retired 2GHz radios (transmitters and receivers) and power amplifiers. Only the specified equipment should be sent.

WHEN TO SHIP RADIOS: Broadcasters will ship the designated radios to Sprint Nextel's warehouse no later than 60 days¹ after their station relocates to the new channel plan. It is okay to ship earlier; we realize broadcasters may choose to ship the retired radios immediately after changing them out for the new equipment.

WHERE TO SHIP RADIOS: Broadcasters should ship radios to Sprint Nextel's warehouse in Abilene, Texas. Address: **Sprint Nextel, Attn: Robert Johnson, 5520 North 1st Street, Abilene, TX 79603-6425, phone number: 1-800-599-7235.**

HOW TO SHIP RADIOS: Broadcasters should use the following United Parcel Service (UPS[®]) shipping account number: **1WR879** (Sprint Nextel pays shipping costs) and associated zip code: **20191**. This account number will only allow shipment of items to our Abilene, Texas warehouse.

Shipment Process Steps:

1. Notify Sprint Nextel's regional Project Manager when ready to ship.
2. Gather all 2GHz radios (transmitters and receivers) and power amplifiers listed on your Schedule B – please don't send in any additional equipment
4. **Write the associated Nextel ID (according to Schedule B) on each individual equipment piece (use a permanent marker or Sharpie[®])**
5. Pack equipment in boxes and weigh each box (weight is needed to prepare shipping label)
 - a. Individual box weight cannot exceed 150 pounds
 - b. Maximum acceptable size is 119 inches in length and 165 inches in length and girth
 - c. Multiple radios may be boxed together
6. PM will provide a copy of Schedule B (if you don't already have a copy). Place a copy in each box - this serves as a packing slip for the warehouse, to ensure you receive appropriate credit for the retired equipment you send in
7. Write "2 GHz Relocation Project" on outside of each box with a permanent marker or Sharpie[®]
8. Call UPS[®] at 1-800 PICK UPS[®] for pickup; driver will have shipping forms you can fill out
NOTE: UPS[®] doesn't allow the forms to be filled out online or downloaded
9. After shipping, provide your Sprint Nextel PM with the UPS[®] Tracking Number for each box shipped

¹ Note that LTTS licensees will have a separate timeframe for equipment return
